The meeting was called to order at 9:46 a.m.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Assembly Bill 361 was passed, which amends the Government Code to allow Brown Act bodies, including the JJDPC, to meet remotely during the continuing State of Emergency, and as state officials continue to recommend social distancing as safety measures. The Act also requires Commissionmembers to reconsider the circumstances of the emergency every 30 days and determine whether the state of emergency continues to directly impact their ability to meet safely in person.

This meeting was held for the express purpose of considering whether the JJDPC should hold its next meeting, now slated for May 26, 2022, remotely.

The motion to meet remotely in May was made by Lynn Houston; seconded by Barbara Kate Repa.

It passed by unanimous vote of the Commission.
